





ASSETS	<u>Critical</u> Information Categories/Silos/Assets? Profiles of each (CIA, Privacy, Safety, Acceptable Use, etc)
ACCESS	Who has access to what (Employers, Suppliers, Contractors, Partners, Regulators, etc)
STORAGE	<u>Units/Zones</u> upon which information resides (People, Devices, Facilities etc)
PROCESSING	Units upon which info/data <u>is processed</u> (Systems, Applications, Brains)
TRANSFER MECHANISMS	Environment in which info/data is transferred (IT Networks, Transportation Infrastructure, etc)
