7	Comments:	<p>Please also be informed, that MOFCOM has now initiated an expiry review of the anti-dumping measures on photo paper.</p> <p>Please find enclosed the notice (EN/CN), petition (CN) and registration form (EN/CN).</p> <p>The two EU companies with individual dumping margins are Kodak (19.4% and Fujifilm (17.5%), residual margin 19.4%.</p> <p>In March 2012, China imposed definitive measures against imports of photographic paper originating in the EU. Duties ranged between 17.5% and 19.4% depending on the company concerned.</p> <p>In June 2016, China increased the existing measures against import of photographic paper originating in the EU, following an interim review. The review only covered products manufactured by FUJIFILM Manufacturing Europe B.V. The new anti-dumping rate for this company is 23,5% (instead of 17,5%).</p>
