SECTION 1

The POSITIONING of ITALY in EUROPE relies on the CONTRIBUTION of LOMBARDIA



Compared to the 27 countries of the European Union, Italy ranks

- #3 in terms of GDP level,
 with over 1/5 generated by Lombardia and 13% by the territories of Assolombarda
- #3 in terms of industry value added,
 with over 1/4 generated by Lombardia and 12% by the territories of Assolombarda
- #3 in terms of services value added,
 with over 1/5 generated by Lombardia and 14% by the territories of Assolombarda
- #3 in terms of exports,
 with over 1/4 generated by Lombardia and 13% by the territories of Assolombarda

Among the 4 main European economies (Germany, France, Italy, Spain), Italy achieves

- the highest economic growth compared to before the pandemic,
 with +4.6% in GDP between 2019 and 2023
- the best per-capita growth compared to before the pandemic, equal to +5.9% in GDP per capita between 2019 and 2023
- the second most relevant expansion into international markets compared to before the pandemic,
 equal to +30.4% in exports between 2019 and 2023
- the most significant reduction in unemployment compared to before the pandemic,
 with -23.3% in the unemployed between 2019 and 2023

SECTION 2

If it were a NATIONAL ECONOMY, LOMBARDIA would be...



Compared to the 27 countries of the European Union, Lombardia ranks

- #10 in terms of GDP level
 - (a little lower than Ireland, higher than Austria)
- #10 in terms of GDP per capita
 - (just below Germany and Finland, widely above France)
- #8 in terms of industry value added
 - (more than Austria and Sweden)
- #5 in terms of industry value added per capita (more than Finland and Sweden, more than double that of Spain)
- #10 in terms of services value added
 - (a little lower than Ireland, higher than Austria)
- #10 in terms of services value added per capita
- #12 in terms of exports

(more than double those of Finland and Portugal)

Among the 4 main European economies (Germany, France, Italy, Spain), Lombardia achieves

- the highest economic growth compared to before the pandemic,
 with +6.7% in GDP between 2019 and 2023
- the strongest per-capita growth compared to before the pandemic, equal to +7.1% in GDP per capita between 2019 and 2023
- the most significant reduction in unemployment compared to before the pandemic,
 with -28.8% in the unemployed between 2019 and 2023

SECTION 3

Even in the REGIONAL EUROPEAN comparison, LOMBARDIA and our TERRITORIES emerge for their RELEVANCE and PERFORMANCE



Among the 10 comparable regions* of Germany, France, Italy, Spain, Lombardia ranks

- #5 in terms of GDP level
- #4 in terms of GDP per capita
- #4 in terms of exports
- #5 in terms of unemployment rate
- #5 in terms of youth unemployment rate

Among the 10 comparable regions* of Germany, France, Italy, Spain, Lombardia achieves

- the highest economic growth compared to before the pandemic, with +6.7% in GDP between 2019 and 2023
- the fourth most relevant expansion into international markets compared to before the pandemic, equal to +28.3% in exports between 2019 and 2023, +31.0% in the territories of Assolombarda
- the most significant reduction in unemployment compared to before the pandemic, with -28.8% in the unemployed between 2019 and 2023
- the most significant reduction in youth unemployment (15-24 years) compared to before the pandemic, with -10.5% in the young unemployed between 2019 and 2023

SECTION 4

LOMBARDIA stands out in the ITALIAN CONTEXT for INTERNATIONAL COMPETITIVENESS



Compared to Italian regions, Lombardia ranks

#1 among Italian regions in exports
(nearly as much as Emilia-Romagna and Veneto combined)

#1 among Italian regions in exported goods' diversification

#1 among Italian regions in Made in Italy+ exports, with 14% of the national total generated by the territories of Assolombarda, of which:

#1 in mechatronics exports,

of which 12% of the national total concentrated in the territories of Assolombarda

#1 in fashion exports.

of which 19% of the national total originating from the territories of Assolombarda

#1 in design & furniture exports,

of which 15% of the national total generated by the territories of Assolombarda

#2 in food & beverage exports,

of which 7% of the national total produced by the territories of Assolombarda

#1 in chemical & pharmaceutical exports,

of which 21% of the national total concentrated in the territories of Assolombarda



% contribution to 27 EU total (2023)



27 EU countries, Lombardia and Italian regions



GDP per capita 27 EU countries and Lombardia







Value Added - Construction 27 EU countries and Lombardia











GDP growth between 2019 and 2023 27 EU countries and Lombardia


chain linked volumes 2015=100, % change

GDP per capita growth between 2019 and 2023 27 EU countries and Lombardia



Exports growth between 2019 and 2023 27 EU countries and Lombardia



15-74 years, % (2023)



Change in the unemployed between 2019 and 2023


27 EU countries and Lombardia

15-74 years, % change








GDP Lombardia and benchmark regions in Europe current values, billion euro (2023)


GDP growth between 2019 and 2023 Lombardia and benchmark regions in Europe

GDP per capita Lombardia and benchmark regions in Europe current prices, euro (2023)





Exports growth between 2019 and 2023 Lombardia and benchmark regions in Europe current prices, % change



15-74 years, % (2023)



15-74 years, % change



15-24 years, % (2023)



Variation in the young unemployed between 2019 and 2023



15-24 years, % change





current prices, % (2023)








