

Edison is the oldest energy company in Europe, with over 140 years of achievements, and is one of the leading operators in the sector in Italy.

The Group – which has over 6,000 employees – is at the forefront of the energy transition challenge in line with the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) and European decarbonization policies.

With over 7 GW of power distributed across the territory, Edison covers 7.5% of the national electricity production. It is an integrated operator: from energy production to the management and maintenance of generation parks, up to the sale to end customers, with more than 200 plants, including hydroelectric power plants, wind and photovoltaic fields, and combined cycle gas turbines (CCGT) among the most efficient in Europe, thanks to the commissioning of two new state-of-the-art plants in Veneto and Campania.

The Group is implementing a development plan in renewable energies aimed at increasing the installed capacity from the current 2 GW to about 5 GW by 2030, bringing green generation to 40% of its production mix.

Edison is committed to diversifying gas supply sources and routes to ensure the security and competitiveness of the national energy system. It also boasts a unique position in Italy, thanks to an import portfolio that meets about 20% of national demand, also dealing with the development of liquefied natural gas (LNG) and green gases (biomethane, BioLNG, and green hydrogen) to replace fossil fuels in energy-intensive industrial processes and make heavy, land, and maritime transport sustainable.

Through Edison Next, the Group is a key operator in the energy and environmental services market, with solutions to decarbonize and optimize the energy consumption of companies and Public Administration, enhancing local resources.

Customer care and proximity are primary objectives of Edison Energia, the Group's company dedicated, since the liberalization of the reference markets, to the sale of electricity, natural gas, and innovative services to end customers, families, businesses, and Public Administration.
