

- Quick installation and configuration



- Developed for Apache server, Wordpress has been installed on Microsoft Internet Information Server Services IIS6
- The ISAPI plug-in (HeliconTech) gives IIS the ability to manage WordPress
- Permalinks problem (mod_rewrite Apache)
- Solution with plug-in ISAPI_ReWrite3 Problem solving between ISAPI_ReWrite3 and Reports






