

- The history of Samarkand is more than 2700 years old and is of the same age as the city of Babylon or Rome.
- Known as Marakanda in the 4th BCE, it was the capital of Sogdiana and was captured by Alexander The Great in 329 BCE.
- Poets and historians of the past called it "Rome of the East.
- Samarkand was the historical capital of the **Temurid's Empire**



History of SAMARKAND



Its advantageous geographical position in the **Zarafshan** valley puts Samarkand to the **first place** among cities of Central Asia



Samarkand, its historical architectural and archaeological monuments are included in the UNESCO World Heritage List under the name "Samarkand - Crossroads of Cultures".

Empire and the center of scientific, educational and cultural enlightenment.

- Over the history this legendary city on the Silk Road went through growths and decays, suffered from destroying invasions of foreign rulers and again revived, becoming more beautiful.
- Trade routes to the west, to Persia, to the east, to China, to the south, to India, intersected here and formed intersections of the Silk Road.

Through which the shortest transport communications run, linking east with west and north with south as an intersection, in the center of the junction of road and rail communications, which gives the region significant benefits in the development of logistics and transport services, trade and expansion of export-import transactions.

ROADS

• Total length - 4097 km (M-37, M-39, A-377, A-378)



RAILWAYS

- Regular train runs through the territory of the Republic of Uzbekistan
- International railway to Russia, Kazakhstan and other CIS countries



AIRPORT

• Located in the city of Samarkand, there are regular flights to Tashkent and international flights to Moscow, St. Petersburg, Kazan, Yekaterinburg, Istanbul and other cities.



CARGO TERMINAL OF NAVOI AIRPORT

• The distance to the city of Samarkand is 160 km.



The new airport has an "Open book" design. The concept is based on the main work of the great scientist Mirzo Ulugbek "The New Astronomical Table of Kuragoni".

- The airport apron will be able to receive up to 20 aircraft
- Today, flights have been launched to 29 countries



New International Airport "SAMARKAND"

became the largest tourist hub in Uzbekistan



 The new terminal was built according to international standards, taking into account the requirements for servicing passengers with limited mobility.



- The new terminal can serve 1000 passengers per/hr (or up to 2 million passengers per/yr).
- The construction project was implemented thanks to the first public-private partnership agreement in the history of aviation in Uzbekistan with "AIR MARAKANDA" LLC and the state partner JSC "Uzbekistan Airports".




Project placement in the FEZ
